The SUNREEF 60 is an excellent example, offering a vast 300-square-meter living area with ceiling heights of 2.2 meters throughout the main deck. Expansive windows cover 80% of the hull's surface, creating an open and immersive connection to the surrounding seascape.



For power catamaran enthusiasts, models like the *Fountaine Pajot MY4.S* and *Aquila 44* feature fold-out beach club platforms, expanding the aft deck for easy access to the water—perfect for day trips to hidden beaches. Compact options such as the *Aquila 32* and *YOT 36* are designed for couples or new boaters, offering space efficiency and easy handling without sacrificing comfort.



The *Cora Cat 48* takes innovation further, incorporating a bridge deck design that enhances comfort by reducing noise from wave impact. Its integrated solar array provides power for essential systems, such as air conditioning, for extended periods—an ideal solution for environmentally conscious long-range cruisers exploring remote destinations.
